

TNC and inter-territorial cooperation are not integrated into the LDS

The Managing Authority (MA) publishes calls for cooperation projects (at least 4x / year)

MA selects preparatory actions and cooperation projects.

The main problems of Cooperation Mechanism in Lithuania

Excess control mechanisms at all stages

Inadequate intensity during the first year prevented start-up with foreign partners

Excess requirements

Suggestions for improvement of Cooperation Mechanism in Lithuania

Integrate TNC funding into LDS

Less paper documents: more electronic standardized documents online

Changing institutional approach: stop evaluate applicants only as a potential infringers.
